



Utahns are Making the Shift to Efficient Landscapes in Record Numbers

he number of applications for landscaping rebates through Utahwatersavers.com was four times higher this year than last—a trend indicating that many Utahns are ready to make the change to a more sustainable landscape. While the double whammy of pandemic and drought may have helped fuel this shift, many in the Utah Green Industry have stepped up to educate clients and to provide resources that make it easier for Utahns to install landscapes that are more resilient and capable of handling the often-unpredictable challenges ahead.

Here is a look at some exciting changes and opportunities that will help this movement grow even more:

Expanded Rebate Offerings through Utahwatersavers.com:

In August 2021, landscaping rebates on *Utahwatersavers.com* were expanded to include additional areas of eligibility. Funding from Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District and Central Utah Water Conservancy District have made Localscapes Rewards and Flip Your Strip Rebates available throughout Salt Lake, Utah, Wasatch, Duchesne, Juan, and Sanpete Counties. Layton residents can also participate in the Flip Your Strip program thanks to funding from Weber Basin Water Conservancy District. It is anticipated these programs will continue to expand, particularly for homeowners remodeling existing yards into high-performing Localscapes. Localscapes Professional Partnering:

Members of UNLA are generally aware of the Localscapes method, a design style created specifically for Utah. The method takes the seven principles of waterwise landscaping, reduces them to actionable steps and melds them with Utah's cultural perception of an "ideal" landscape. The end result? A way of landscaping that can look traditional but uses just 50% (or less) of the water consumed in a traditional landscape and can be more easily managed over time. Localscaping is becoming increasingly popular with residents and is even required for new construction in some rapidly growing communities. If you have not yet teamed up with the movement, this is a great time to join us.

Partnering with Localscapes is free and open to all licensed, Utah green industry

businesses. Partners receive vetted referral traffic, "official" Localscapes Partner logos and branding to use in promoting their businesses, social media promotion to potential clients, and long-term client support and education provided by a team of experts that you don't have to pay! 
